Tip on Signage from Cody the Code Ranger



Question for Cody: Where and how can I post signage in the City?

Answer: Signs can be posted on private property, with the property owner's permission. The signs must be placed two feet back from the sidewalk or ten feet from the street or curb. Posting or attaching any sign to utility poles or street signs is not allowed at any time.
