Remains of Missing Wheat Ridge Woman Recovered

Remains Discovered in Park County Identified as Those of Leann “Annie” Meyer

Wheat Ridge Colorado ~ On July 4, investigators with the Park County Sheriff’s Office were called after a group of people found what appeared to be human remains near their cabin around 7:00 P.M. The Park County Sheriff’s Office immediately began searching and processing the scene with a full team of investigators.

Detectives with the Wheat Ridge Police Department were notified about the discovery on Monday (7/8) morning. Through the investigation and forensic analysis of evidence, it became apparent that the remains recovered were those of missing Wheat Ridge woman Leann “Annie” Meyer. Our detectives then began surveying the scene with Park County Investigators.

Signs of significant animal activity around the body were apparent during the investigation. Detectives with the Wheat Ridge Police Department are currently working with Park County Investigators on this case. Part of this process will include multiple searches of the area where Leann Meyer’s remains were recovered. Neither the manner nor cause of death have been determined as of yet. There was some additional evidence collection at the scene in addition to Ms. Meyer’s remains. A forensic evaluation of that evidence will now be conducted to determine the importance, if any, to the investigation.
