**TITLE: A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2015 GENERAL FUND BUDGET TO REFLECT THE APPROVAL OF A SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET APPROPRIATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$39,992 FOR THE PURCHASE OF A REPLACEMENT POLICE PATROL SPORT UTILITY VEHICLE (SUV)**

**WHEREAS**, Police Patrol Unit 55 incurred non-repairable accident damage; and

**WHEREAS**, the Wheat Ridge Police Department wishes to replace Police Patrol Unit 55; and

**WHEREAS**, the \$39,992 cost for replacing Unit 55 exceeds the amount budgeted for fleet replacement in the 2015 Budget; and

**WHEREAS**, the City is able to purchase the vehicle from Sill-Terhar Motors, Inc. of Broomfield, Colorado, under the Colorado Price Agreement for \$31,992; and

**WHEREAS**, the additional outfitting of the vehicle for police use is estimated at \$8,000, bringing the replacement cost to \$39,992; and

**WHEREAS**, the Wheat Ridge Charter requires that amendments to the budget be effected by the City Council adopting a Resolution.


**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council:

**Supplemental Appropriation**

Section 1. The City Council authorizes the transfer of \$39,992 from the General Fund undesignated reserves to account number 01-303-800-807 and amendment of the General Fund revenue accordingly.

Section 2: The City Council authorizes the purchase and outfitting of one police patrol 2016 Ford Explorer SUV for a total amount of \$39,992.
