TITLE: A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND SUPPORTING A HEAL GRANT APPLICATION TO FUND A CITY DIRECTIONAL AND DISTANCE SIGN PROGRAM THAT WILL EFFICIENTLY AND SAFELY GUIDE PEDESTRIANS AND BICYCLISTS TO PUBLIC PARKS AND RECREATION FACILITIES.

WHEREAS, Wheat Ridge passed a resolution to support Livewell Colorado's Healthy Eating Active Living Cities and Towns Campaign; and

WHEREAS, City Council continues to support policies, programs, and projects that facilitate health and wellness; and

WHEREAS, City Council adopted the 2010 Wheat Ridge Bike and Pedestrian Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, City Council adopted the 2015 Parks and Recreation Master Plan that addressed the need for increased wayfinding and mileage signage; and

WHEREAS, the transportation system in Wheat Ridge and the City's parks and recreation facilities are vital to the City's health and wellness.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Wheat Ridge, Colorado, as follows:


- A. City Council is supportive of improving active living by adding directional and distance signage to encourage people to walk or bike to parks and recreation facilities.
- B. The City of Wheat Ridge will submit a HEAL Mini Grant to help fund directional and distance signage.
