TITLE: A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2018 2E BOND FUND BUDGET TO REFLECT THE APPROVAL OF A SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET APPROPRIATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$447,708 FOR THE PURPOSE OF REVISING THE ANDERSON PARK MASTER PLAN TO RETAIN A LIGHTED BASEBALL FIELD AND ADD A REMOVABLE OUTFIELD FENCE TO ALLOW FOR A MULTI-USE FIELD

WHEREAS, the renovation of Anderson Park is one of four projects approved by voters through the 2E Bond Issue, Investing 4 the Future, in November 2016; and

WHEREAS, City Council wishes to revise the Anderson Park Master Plan to retain a lighted baseball field with a removable outfield fence to allow for a multi-use field; and

WHEREAS, additional funding in the amount of \$447,708 is required to retain a lighted baseball field with a removable outfield fence and multi-use field; and

WHEREAS, the Wheat Ridge Charter requires that amendments to the budget be effected by the City Council adopting a resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Wheat Ridge, Colorado, as follows:


A transfer of \$447,708 is hereby approved from Fund 31 budget undesignated reserves to account #31-104-800-805 and the 2018 revenues are amended accordingly.
