RESOLUTION NO. 19

TITLE: A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2020 GENERAL FUND BUDGET TO REFLECT THE APPROVAL OF A SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET APPROPRIATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$250,000 FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING A BUSINESS RECOVERY PROGRAM AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO IMPLEMENT SAID PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Wheat Ridge Charter requires that amendments to the budget be effected by the City Council adopting a resolution; and

WHEREAS, Wheat Ridge City Council acknowledges the hardship imposed by the COVID-19 emergency; and

WHEREAS, the Council recognizes the importance and significance of small businesses to the health and vitality of Wheat Ridge; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds that assistance is necessary to support businesses during this time; and

WHEREAS, the Council wishes to establish and fund a business recovery program for eligible businesses within the City; and

WHEREAS, insufficient appropriations in the 2020 Budget exist to cover this program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Wheat Ridge City Council, that:

- Section 1. A transfer of \$250,000 is hereby approved from the General Fund undesignated reserves to account 01-105-700-719 and the 2020 revenues are amended accordingly.

- Section 2. The City Manager is authorized and directed to implement a small business recovery program for eligible businesses within the City, and to develop eligibility criteria and procedures for the same.
