**TITLE: A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2020 GENERAL FUND BUDGET TO REFLECT THE APPROVAL OF A SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET APPROPRIATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$250,000 FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING PHASE TWO OF THE BUSINESS STABILIZATION PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, the Wheat Ridge Charter requires that amendments to the budget be effected by the City Council adopting a resolution; and

**WHEREAS**, Wheat Ridge City Council acknowledges the hardship imposed by the COVID-19 emergency; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council recognizes the importance and significance of small businesses to the health and vitality of Wheat Ridge; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council finds that assistance is necessary to support businesses during this time; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council wishes to establish and fund a business recovery program for eligible businesses within the City; and


**WHEREAS**, insufficient appropriations in the 2020 Budget exist to cover this program.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Wheat Ridge City Council, that:

Section 1. A transfer of \$250,000 is hereby approved from the General Fund undesignated reserves to account 01-610-700-777 and the 2020 revenues are amended accordingly.

Section 2. The Council hereby incorporates by reference the findings and statement of public purpose set forth in Resolution 25, Series 2020.
