**TITLE: A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2021 2E BOND FUND BUDGET TO REFLECT THE APPROVAL OF A SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET APPROPRIATION FOR THE RE-APPROPRIATION AND RE-ENCUMBRANCE OF 2020 FISCAL YEAR ENCUMBERED FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,748,421.94 FOR WADSWORTH BOULEVARD RIGHTS-OF-WAY ACQUISITIONS**

**WHEREAS**, the City's independent auditor has recommended that the City utilize generally accepted accounting principles (GAAP) for its budgeting basis which requires all encumbrances to expire at year end; and

**WHEREAS**, purchase orders with encumbered funds to purchase remaining rights-of-way on Wadsworth Boulevard remained open on December 31, 2020; and


**WHEREAS**, to continue to acquire rights-of-way prior to construction in 2021 a supplemental budget appropriation is necessary to transfer the funds from the Fund 31 unreserved fund balance to the specific 2021 budget line items.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Wheat Ridge, Colorado, as follows:

The City of Wheat Ridge fiscal year 2021 2E Bond Fund (31) Budget be amended accordingly, specifically transferring funds from the Fund 31 fund balance to the following accounts:

31-103-700-750 - \$22,000  
31-103-800-803 - \$2,726,421.94
