

Investing 4 the Future

- Citizen-led DIRT (Drainage, Infrastructure, Roads, and Trails) Task Force identified high priority capital improvement projects
- The task force selected 4 high priority projects
- On the November 2016 ballot, voters approved the 2E ballot question providing a 12 year, ½ cent per dollar temporary sales/use tax increase for the 4 projects.
- The four projects that are moving forward include:
 - Anderson Park (± \$4M)
 - Wadsworth Boulevard Widening (± \$7M)
 - I-70 Hook Ramps at Clear Creek Crossing (± \$10M)
 - Wheat Ridge · Ward Station (± \$12M)

Possible Projects at the Station Area

- Several possible projects have been explored
- Improvements to 52nd, Tabor, and Ridge are advancing in partnership with the City of Arvada
- Some road/streetscape improvements will come with development
- Pedestrian bridge and linear park in early phases of exploration
- Ponds are privately owned, regional park may still have recreational amenities
