What's Happened?

NRS Blitz Week

March 18-21 was NRS Blitz Week with presentations and discussions at both City Council and Planning Commission, as well as four open houses across the city over two days. In total, nearly 100 people attended the open houses to learn about emerging ideas and provide feedback to help shape the NRS.



City Council NRS Retreat

In early April, City Council met in a retreat setting to discuss the findings of the NRS and the implications of the ideas that have emerged. City Council's conversation was critical to understanding what the City would be able to implement and how.



What's Next?

The NRS update process is nearing its conclusion. Following nine months of hard work by the project steering committee, seven months of **public engagement**, discussions with City Council and Planning Commission, and a day-long City Council retreat, the **consulting team has begun writing the draft Neighborhood Revitalization Strategy**. It will be available for public review in May with further City Council and Planning Commission consideration no later than June.
