

The City of Wheat Ridge and Sustainable Wheat Ridge Seek Businesses Interested In Free Bike Racks



The City of Wheat Ridge and the Sustainable Wheat Ridge resident advisory committee are funding the capital and installation costs for bicycle racks in Wheat Ridge. Bicycle use reduces automotive traffic and pollution, while increasing community engagement and resident health. By improving the available bicycle facilities in Wheat Ridge, the City aims to increase bicycle use throughout public spaces.

Applications are open now and will be due by Friday, May 21 (National Bike to Work Day).

Application Guidelines

1. Bicycle rack must be publicly accessible
2. Location must be in Wheat Ridge city limits
3. Bicycle rack must not impede pedestrian or vehicle traffic
4. Applicant must secure property owner permission
5. Property owners are responsible for upkeep of the bicycle racks

Funding awards are decided by City of Wheat Ridge and Sustainable Wheat Ridge. The evaluation team will choose recipients based on community needs and impact. A site plan is required when submitting an application.
