The following information is provided to all prospective bidders and is hereby made a part of the above bid documents. Bidders must acknowledge this Addendum 4 with their bid. It is a total of two pages.

**CLARIFICATION, ADDITIONAL INFORMATION, AND CHANGES:**

**NOTE: THIS is ADDENDUM #4.**

Addendum #1 was created in RMEPS/BidNet when adding the bid documents to the site after the original posting.

Addendum #2 was posted on April 29, 2021 and includes the geotechnical report.

Addendum #3 was posted on May 3, 2021 and includes the Mandatory Pre-Bid Attendee list and PowerPoint slides.

- 1. The utility section of the specifications typically has a duration that the contractor should assume for each of the relocations to be completed by the utility company. If this information is not provided the contractor cannot prepare an accurate schedule for the project. Please provide the durations expected for each of the utilities to be relocated by the utility companies.**

Many of the dry utility relocations will be in joint trenches, which will be provided by the contractor, and so will be dependent on contractor's phasing and management of the joint trench construction. Other dry utility relocations need project demolition to be done prior to the dry utilities being relocated and so again will be dependent on the contractor's schedule.

- 2. Reference Bid Item No. 202-00035, Removal of Pipe.**

**Please provide a breakdown of pipe sizes and type of pipe material and existing storm structure/manhole that is to be removed.** This information was not tabulated, as the storm system is being replaced and the specifications of the existing system was not needed for design. The survey file provides as much of the existing information as could be gathered by the surveyors (some invert elevations, some pipe sizes, some MH and inlet depths, etc). The City will provide the survey file with the .dgn files in a future addendum (see #6 below as well).

- 3. Sheets 301 and 302, Backside and Frontside Footer. Current annotation on the plan sheets for the backside and frontside footers do not clearly define the start and stop locations for the footers. Can a tabulation by location and length be provide for the backside and front side footers.**

Sheet 47 (Wadsworth Blvd. Miscellaneous Tabulations) contains a table with the beginning/ending stations, lengths, heights, and types of all backside and frontside footers.

- 4. Can there be a job showing on site with the City of Wheat Ridge?**

Wadsworth is easily accessible to drive or walk, and we encourage you to do that on your own. The City of Wheat Ridge will not be conducting Wadsworth job showing(s).

- 5. Section 626 public information services is not included in the bid schedule. Please clarify what is required from the contractor.**

Much of the public information requirements for the project will be done by Merge Resource Group Ltd as a sub-contractor to AECOM, Inc. As a CDOT PROJECT SPECIAL PROVISION, you will find Section 626 – Public Information Services described on page 262 of the bid document for this project

specifically describes the responsibilities deemed incidental to the work. Additionally, Subsection 626.02 states “Public Information Management shall not be measured and paid for separately but shall be included in the cost of item 626 Mobilization”.

**6. Can you please direct me to the .dgn files referenced below from Addendum 3?**

Addendum #2 was posted on April 29, 2021. .dgn files are now available on... understanding that any associated electronic files that are made available are provided for convenience only, and The City of Wheat Ridge and its consultants assume no responsibility for any inconsistencies or discrepancies between electronic files and the printed Plans and Specifications.

**Apologies for the statement above being included, as it was premature. The .dgn files are being prepared and will be included in a future addendum.**

**Are electronic files available during the bidding process?** Yes. However, the electronic files are being prepared and will be provided in a future addendum with the understanding that any associated electronic files that are made available are provided for convenience only, and the City of Wheat Ridge and its consultants assume no responsibility for any inconsistencies or discrepancies between electronic files and the printed Plans and Specifications.

a. **Are Electronic Design Files (.dwg) available for the project?** Dwg files are not available. The project was completed in Microstation, so .dgn files will be made available as noted above.

**7. Is there a detail for the “light Standard Foundation Special”?**

The foundation special are the City pedestrian light foundation (City detail LG)...subset sheet 16 of 20, sheet 356.

**8. We had not been able to find a drawing for the speed tables, can you please direct us to it?**

There are no typical speed table detail in the plans. Each location has station/elev layout information at key locations.

**9. Do the green stripes on the roadway plans at the driveway relate to the conflicts zone in the striping plans?**

Yes, those are the conflict markings from the striping plans.

**10. What dowel bar spacing will you require for the 10 and 11’ lanes?**

The dowel bar spacing would be the same as noted in M-Standard M-412; dowel bars 12 inches on center across the transverse joints. Tie bars would be No. 5 bars spaced 36 inches on center for longitudinal joints also in conformance with M-Standard M-412.

**11. How will the project be awarded? The bid schedule has a base bid, several options and then water and Sanitary. Will the City of Wheat Ridge take the lowest bidder with all the tabs combined or pick and choose certain options?**

Depending on the prices received, the City currently believes that there is funding available to award the Base Bid, Options 1 and 4, and the Water and Sewer options. Options 2 and 3 will only be awarded if favorable pricing is received that allows those options to be awarded.

**12. We’re unclear as to what you’re asking for with the “insurance commitment statement”. Do you just want a certificate of insurance?**

For bidding purposes, the City is asking bidders to acknowledge that insurance requirements will be maintained in minimum amounts stated, providing protection to additional insured parties by all contractors and sub-contractors. Providing a certificate of insurance at this time is not required.
